- Yellow Ochre
- Cad Orange
- Cad Red Medium
- Alizarin Crimson
- Burnt Sienna (Winsor Newton)
- **Raw Umber**
- Ivory Black
- Dioxazine Purple
- Ultramarine Blue
- Phthalo Blue
- Phthalo Turquoise
- Permanent Green Lt.



Brushes and Palette Knives:

- Bristle Flat brushes 4, 6, 8, 12. Robert Simmons Signet and Princeton Ashley series are great.
- Blick Wonder White Flats 8, 12, 20
- Several Small syntheVc round brushes for drawing
- One or two larger sable rounds or fans for softening.
- 1-inch, 3-inch, and 6-inch putty knives (pictured at top)



Supports, Mediums, Palette, Etc. :

- 2H Pencil (Dull)
- Ruler
- 3 panels or Canvases in whatever size you are comfortable with. If you like to work small then 11 x 14 will do. But you can work larger, as on one of the cityscapes, I will go as large as 14 x 18.

- Liquin Original
- Linseed Oil and Gamsol/OMS
- *Catalyst wedge rubber tools, mini 04 from Blick
- Brush Washer
